Keynote Speaker

Mike Ash, author of *Shaken Faith Syndrome* and *Of Faith and Reason*

Michael Ash is on the management team for the Foundation for Apologetic Information and Research (FAIR) and is the owner and operator of the MormonFortress.com website. He has presented papers at several FAIR Conferences and Sunstone Symposiums and his most recent FAIR Conference paper—on the subject of Shaken Faith Syndrome—was summarized in an article in the *LDS Church News*. Mike has written over 80 on-line articles on Mormon issues and has been published in the *FARMS Review of Books* (BYU's Maxwell Institute), as well as in *Sunstone* magazine, and *Dialogue: A Journal of Mormon Thought*.

In June of 2008 FAIR published Mike's book, *Shaken Faith Syndrome: Strengthening One's Testimony in the Face of Criticism and Doubt*. Dr. Brian Hauglid, associate professor of ancient scripture at BYU called it "one of the most important books for LDS members with questions..." and LDS scholar Larry Morris says that "every person ...worried about their faith—or the faith of a loved one—should be told about this book."

In December of 2008 Cedar Fort published Mike's latest book, *Of Faith and Reason: 80 Evidences Supporting the Prophet Joseph Smith* which Steve Smoot of the *American Testament Blog* calls "a must read for any Latter-day Saint interested in learning about the latest scholarly material supporting the claims of the Prophet Joseph Smith."

Mike's church callings have varied but he typically has been called to teaching positions. He and his wife Chris live in Ogden. They are the parents of three daughters and have four grandchildren.
